Use Insert Video button in HTML editor

Upload the file to the server using the Video button in HTML editor

- Click on **Video** icon in HTML editor toolbar
- Upload video or choose from server
- Fill required fields
- Click OK

Use Insert/Edit button in HTML editor

Upload the file to the server using the Insert/Edit link in HTML editor

- Click on Insert/Edit icon
- Click on the **Upload** tab
- Browse server to find your file

Change the HTML source code to point to the video

- Click on the **Source** button in the HTML editor to update the HTML
- Replace the video link that you just created from:

/kb_upload/file/video.mp4

to:

Where *video.mp4* is the name of your video file. Use your own width and height values to suit, or you can remove the width and height altogether, or use only width or only height.
