If the result is httpd\_can\_sendmail off ... SELinux is preventing the connection. Allow it by:

setsebool httpd\_can\_sendmail=1

...and check again to make sure the change was applied:

[root@webserver ~]# sestatus -b | grep sendmail

The result should be

httpd\_can\_sendmail on
